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DAY TO DAY DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1: Nairobi → Amboseli National Park

Distance: Approx. 240 km • *Drive Time:* 4–5 hours

Your safari begins with an early morning pick-up from your Nairobi hotel or Jomo Kenyatta International Airport.

After meeting your professional safari guide, you'll depart for Amboseli through the scenic Athi Plains, passing traditional Maasai homesteads and expansive savannah landscapes.

Arrive at Kibo Safari camp in time for lunch and relaxation before your first afternoon game drive.

Afternoon highlights



Amboseli is famous for its enormous elephant herds and spectacular views of Mount Kilimanjaro, Africa's tallest mountain. During your first drive you'll begin searching for elephants, lions, cheetahs, giraffes, zebras, buffaloes, hyenas, and numerous antelope species.

Return to camp before sunset for dinner and your first night surrounded by the sounds of the African wilderness.

DAY 2: FULL DAY IN AMBOSELI NATIONAL PARK

Wake before sunrise for one of Kenya's most rewarding wildlife experiences.

Sunrise game drive



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The early morning offers the clearest views of Mount Kilimanjaro before clouds gather around its peak. Wildlife is highly active, making this the ideal time to photograph elephants against the snow-capped mountain.

You'll explore different ecosystems including:

- Acacia woodlands
- Open grasslands
- Seasonal marshes
- Observation Hill overlooking the wetlands

Enjoy a picnic lunch inside the park or return to camp depending on wildlife movements.

As the golden light returns, enjoy another leisurely game drive before heading back to Kibo Safari camp

DAY 3: AMBOSELI → LAKE NAIVASHA

Distance: Approx. 310 km • Drive Time: 5–6 hours

After breakfast, depart Amboseli and journey north through Kenya's dramatic Great Rift Valley.

Along the way you'll stop at one of the Rift Valley viewpoints where the escarpment stretches for hundreds of kilometers across East Africa.





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Arrive at Lake Naivasha Sopa in the afternoon and check into your lakeside accommodation.

Afternoon activities

- Boat safari among hippos
- Crescent Island walking safari
- Bird watching (fish eagles, pelicans, kingfishers)
- Nature walk within the lodge gardens

The peaceful atmosphere of Lake Naivasha offers a beautiful contrast to the savannahs you've explored.

DAY 4: NAIVASHA → LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK

Drive Time: 1.5–2 Hours

After breakfast, enjoy a leisurely drive to Lake Nakuru National Park, one of Kenya's premier rhino sanctuaries.

Upon arrival, begin a game drive before checking into Sarova Lion Hill for lunch.

Afternoon game drive



Lake Nakuru is famous for its remarkable conservation success and offers excellent opportunities to see:

- White rhinos
- Black rhinos
- Rothschild giraffes



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- Tree-climbing lions
- Flamingos (season permitting)

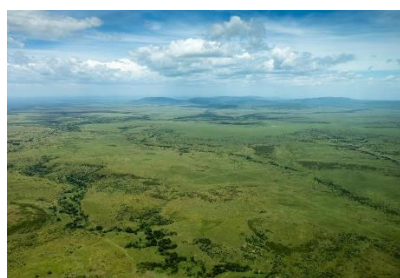

DAY 5: LAKE NAKURU → MASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

Following breakfast, depart for the world-renowned Masai Mara National Reserve.

The drive passes through rolling highlands before descending into the vast grasslands that form part of the greater Serengeti ecosystem.



Arrive at Zebra Plains for lunch before embarking on your first afternoon game drive **(Optional)**

Expect sightings of:

- Lions resting beneath acacia trees
- Towering giraffes
- Herds of elephants
- Wildebeest and zebra
- Thomson's and Grant's gazelles

The Masai Mara is renowned for predator density, making every drive full of anticipation.

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DAY 6: FULL DAY MASAI MARA SAFARI

Today is dedicated to exploring one of Africa's greatest wildlife destinations.

Leave camp early with packed picnic lunches for an immersive full-day safari across different regions of the reserve.



The day's experiences

Visit the Mara River, home to hippos and enormous Nile crocodiles, while your guide tracks wildlife using years of field experience.

Depending on the season, you may witness:

- The Great Migration
- River crossings
- Predator hunts
- Massive herds stretching across the plains

Enjoy lunch beneath a shaded tree overlooking the savannah before continuing your afternoon exploration.

DAY 7: MASAI MARA – WILDLIFE & MAASAI CULTURE

A slower morning allows for another rewarding game drive before returning to camp for breakfast.

Later, you'll have the opportunity to visit an authentic Maasai Village and learn about one of Africa's most celebrated pastoral cultures.



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Cultural highlights

- Traditional Maasai dances
- Village homestead tour
- Livestock traditions
- Beadwork craftsmanship
- Insights into Maasai coexistence with wildlife

In the evening, enjoy your final sunset game drive as the Mara transforms into golden hues—an unforgettable conclusion to your safari adventure.

DAY 8: MASAI MARA → NAIROBI

Distance: Approx. 270 km • Drive Time: 5–6 hours

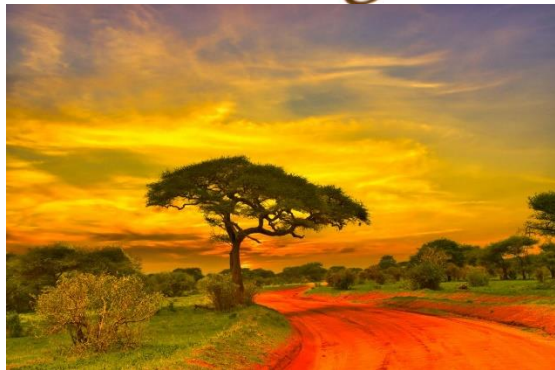
Enjoy breakfast before checking out and beginning your journey back to Nairobi.
